ORDER

On January 22, 2020, Monroe County Water District (Monroe District) advised the Commission of its acceptance of the amount of revenue increase set forth in the Commission Staff Report (Staff Report) issued January 9, 2020, but requested that the rate increase be implemented in annual rate changes over a three-year phase-in period. Monroe District also waived its right to request an informal conference or a formal hearing.

Having reviewed Monroe District's January 22, 2020 comments to the Staff Report and all other relevant information, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Within 14 days from the date of this Order, Monroe District should publish a one-time notice following the requirements of 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5. The customer notice should be formatted as set forth in the Appendix to this Order.
- 2. Monroe District should provide proof of publication of the notice to the Commission no later than February 28, 2020.
- 3. Any motion to intervene based on Monroe District's acceptance of the revenue requirement proposed in the Staff Report and Monroe District's request for a three-year phase-in period should be filed no later than February 28, 2020.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Within 14 days from the date of this Order, Monroe District shall publish a one-time notice following the requirements of 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5. The customer notice shall be formatted as set forth in the Appendix to this Order.
- 2. Monroe District shall provide proof of publication of the notice to the Commission no later than February 28, 2020.
- 3. Any motion to intervene based on Monroe District's acceptance of the revenue requirement proposed in the Staff Report shall be filed no later than February 28, 2020.

NOTICE

On September 4, 2019, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Monroe County Water District's (Monroe District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$175,996, approximately an 8.54 percent increase. After performing a review of Monroe District's application and records, the PSC Staff recommended that Monroe District be granted an increase in water service revenues of approximately 30.55 percent. Pursuant to the PSC's Order of September 24, 2019, in Case No. 2019-00293, Monroe District requested that the PSC approve the PSC Staff-recommended revenue requirement and that Monroe District be allowed to implement the revised rates over a three-year phase-in period as follows:
