ORDER

On September 13, 2019, Complainant, Vanessa Allen, tendered a complaint against Defendant, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) regarding the construction of a new 12-inch high-pressure gas pipeline to connect to the Calvary Pipeline in Bullitt County, Kentucky. On October 2, 2019, the Commission entered an Order dismissing three of the four claims in the complaint based on findings that the relief requested was beyond the scope of the Commission's jurisdiction. As to the fourth claim in the complaint, the Commission found that it did not establish a prima facie case pursuant 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20, and ordered that the Complainant shall have 20 days to file an amended complaint with the Commission that conforms to the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20, and states a prima facie case. More than 75 days have passed since the entry of that Order and the Complainant has not filed an amended complaint or any other response to the Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The complaint in this matter is dismissed without prejudice.
- 2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
