
Also, it should be noted that the bulk loading rate of \$9.00 per 1000 gallons will remain the same.





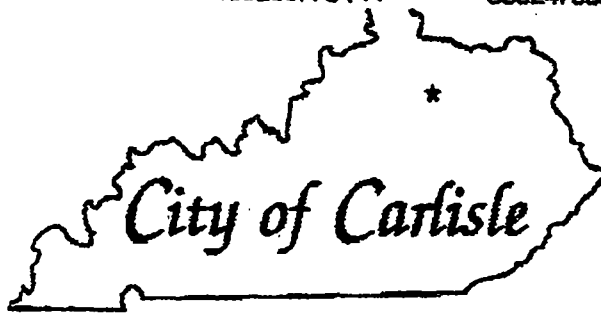
