

If the minimum usage is 2,000 gallons then the purchased water adjustment factor would be added to the minimum bill twice.</p>

A RESOLUTION OF THE BREATHITT COUNTY WATER DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED RATE INCREASE FOR THE COUNTY WATER SYSTEM AS APPROVED BY THE BREATHITT COUNTY WATER DISTRICT BOARD.

Whereas, the Breathitt County Water District Board did pass and approve a proposed rate increase for the Breathitt County Water District Systems at the June 11, 2019 Special Board Meeting.

Whereas, the motion was made and approved by a vote of 4 that we accept the City of Jackson's rate increase from \$3.73 to \$3.85 and approve the Breathitt Water District to increase the minimum bill from \$29.09 to \$29.45 and increase the per thousand, after the first two thousand gallon, from \$14.55 per thousand to \$14.73 per thousand to become effective for service rendered on and after July 15, 2019.

Whereas, cause for the proposed rate increase was impending the rate increase of purchased water from the City of Jackson.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Breathitt County Water Board that the proposed rate increase for the Water System will become effective for services rendered on and after July 15, 2019.
