RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a regular meeting of the Green-Taylor Water District was held at the offices of the District at 250 Industrial Park Road, Greensburg, Kentucky, at 5:00 p.m., Central Time, on August 6, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Chairman Bill Netherland presided over said meeting and the following duly qualified and acting commissioners of the District, and being all such commissioners, were present:

WHEREAS, the Green-Taylor Water District is a water district created and organized under the provisions of KRS Chapter 74. The District is subject to the jurisdiction of the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC");

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that the District take appropriate action to adjust its water rates and charges;

WHEREAS, KRS 278.180 and 807 KAR 5:076 provide the legal mechanism for the District to propose adjustments to its water rates and charges;

WHEREAS, upon motion by Richard Milby, and seconded by Terry Mardis, it was unanimously passed and resolved that:

(a) The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution;

(b) The District proposes to adjust its monthly water rates and charges as set forth in Appendix A, which is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. The proposed rates and charges set forth in Appendix A are subject to any minor adjustments that might be made by the PSC. The proposed rate adjustment shall not become effective until PSC approval has been obtained.

(c) The Chairman and the Office Managers are hereby and directed to prepare, execute, and file with the PSC, by utilizing the Alternative Rate Adjustment Procedure for Small Utilities set forth in 807 KAR 5:076, an Alternative Rate Filing ("ARF") Application, Tariff Sheets, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.





Exhibit 6: Proposed Water Rates

Subject to the minimum water rates specified above, the following metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons of water consumption per month to customers of all connections.

5/8" x 3/4" Meters:

First	2,000 gallons	\$22.44 minimum bill
Next	3,000 gallons	9.37 per 1,000 per gallons
Next	5,000 gallons	7.51 per 1,000 per gallons
Over	10,000 gallons	4.82 per 1,000 per gallons

3/4" Meters:

First	3,000 gallons	\$31.82 minimum bill
Next	2,000 gallons	9.37 per 1,000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons	7.51 per 1,000 gallons
Over	10,000 gallons	4.82 per 1,000 per gallons

1" Meter:

First	5,000 gallons	\$50.57 minimum bill
Next	5,000 gallons	7.51 per 1,000 gallons
Over	10,000 gallons	4.82 per 1,000 per gallons

1 1/2" Meter:

First	10,000 gallons	\$88.16 minimum bill
Over	10,000 gallons	4.82 per 1,000 per gallons

2" Meters:

First	20,000 gallons	\$136.43 minimum bill
Over	10,000 gallons	4.82 per 1,000 per gallons
