Memo Big Sandy Water District Phase V Water System Improvements

Re: Case No. 2019-0027 Application for CPCN Proposed Water Rate Schedule affecting Formerly Overland Development and Cannonsburg Water District

Pursuant to discussion with Ms. Frederick & Staff with PSC yesterday at 2 p.m. our comments are as follows:

1. The intent of the **PROPOSED RATES** by BSWD is to bill the former customers of Overland Development under Division 1 and <u>eliminate</u> Division 2 as included in PSC Case No. 2016-00423. The Big Sandy Water District purchased Overland Development System in 2016 and currently operates and maintains the former facilities under the Big Sandy Water District and continuously bills those customers under the Division 2 of tariff. By eliminating the operation and maintenance of an existing approximately 121 resident private water system and now operating under the umbrella of an approximate 4700 customer water system, the rates for Overland Development can be lowered to match the **proposed rates** of formerly Division 1 and <u>not reduce revenue</u>.

The Overland Development has 121 residential customers with $\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{3}{4}$ " meters. In the calendar year 2018, these 121 customers used 4,929,400 gallons. This computes to an average bill of 3400 gal./month. That **current** average bill would be \$39.49. Using the "Proposed Rate Schedule" the average bill for 3400 gal./month would be \$40.81. Therefore, the former Overland Development customers will be paying an average of \$1.32 additional per month on their average bill.

- 2. Also, the BSWD has concluded that due to lack of amount of wholesale water purchased by the Cannonsburg Water District over last 3 years (2017 16,400 gal, 2018 9,400 gal, 2019 to date 0 gal), the BSWD wishes to bill them off the proposed rate schedule and eliminate the wholesale rate included in PSC case No. 2016-00423. The Cannonsburg Water District has one point of purchase from a 2" meter.
- 3. We concur that the Proposed Rate Schedule set out in our F.E.R. (Final Engineering Report) and application for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity may be confusing as stated herein. It is the District's <u>intent</u> to <u>eliminate</u> the two (2) rates for Overland Development & Cannonsburg Water District. Subsequently, we have included herewith the "Revised" Proposed Rate Schedule.
