MOTION TO AMEND APPLICATION

The Applicant, Big Sandy Water District (the "District"), by Counsel, files this Motion to Amend Application in response to the August 26, 2019 Order.

The Applicant hereby moves the Commission to amend the original Application in Case No. 2019-00275 as follows:

- (1) Applicant requests Commission approval to unify its current retail rate structure for Division 1 and Division 2.
- (2) Applicant has received Amendment No. 2 to the USDA, Rural Development ("RD") Letter of Conditions, which Amendment sets forth the revised rates required by RD to provide financing for the proposed Project (see **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto).
- (3) Applicant has arranged for the publication (publication date is August 28, 2019) of a revised Notice of Proposed Rate Change which complies with 807 KAR 5:069, Section 3 (see **Exhibit "B"** attached hereto). Applicant will file the required Affidavit of Publication and Tearsheet as soon as same is available.

Dear Chairman Thomas:

This letter shall serve as Amendment No. 2 to the Letter of Conditions dated November 20, 2018 and Amendment No. 1 dated July 22, 2019. The purpose of this amendment is to revise the user rates in order to provide additional revenue to cover the subsequent loan.

Paragraph numbered "32" is revised to read as follows:

"32. Rates and Charges:

Rates and charges for facilities and services rendered by the District must be at least adequate to meet cost of maintaining, repairing and operating the water system and meeting required principal and interest payments and the required deposits to debt service and/or depreciation reserve.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGE

In accordance with the requirements of the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") as set out in 807 KAR 5:069, Section 3, notice is hereby given to the customers of the **Big Sandy Water District ("District")** of a change in water rates for users of the District's water system. The changes in water rates are required by USDA, Rural Development ("RD") in connection with a loan from RD to the District in the amount of \$2,065,000 to be evidenced by the issuance by the District of its waterworks revenue bonds in such amount, which RD has agreed to purchase provided the District meets certain conditions of RD, including revising the water rates as set forth below:

The proposed monthly water rates shall be effective for water sold after the date of the final approving Order of the PSC, which Order is expected to be issued no later than 30 days of the filing of the Application. The Application for approval of the rate change has been filed with the PSC and may be examined during normal business hours at the following locations: (i) Big Sandy Water District, 18200 State Rt. #3, Catlettsburg, KY 41129; (ii) PSC, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., E.T.; and (iii) via the PSC website at http://psc.ky.gov. Comments regarding the Application may be submitted to the PSC via its website or by mail to PSC, P.O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602.

The proposed rates are required under the terms of an agreement between the District and RD and KRS 278.023 does not grant the PSC any discretionary authority to modify or reject any portion of the agreement between the District and RD, or to defer the issuance of all necessary orders to implement the terms of the agreement. The RD loan proceeds will be used to finance the costs of the (i) sandblasting, rehab, repainting of (7) seven ground storage tanks at Fuller Ridge, Cunningham Hill, Quarry Branch, Rush Hill, Bowling Drive, Buchanan, U.S. 23 and also repairs and caulking at U.S. 23 glass lined tank; (ii) replacing (3) three existing (28 yr. old) pump stations at Quarry Branch, Fuller Ridge and Cunningham Hill and furnish and install variable frequency drives (VFD's) at U.S. 60 pump station and The Point pump station to improve efficiency of operation and decrease power use; (iii) replacing (7) seven stream crossings by HDD (horizontal directional drilling) with HDPE (high density poly ethylene pipe); replacing 41,100 L.F. of Blue Max 3/4" service line, replacing 5,900 L.F. of 1" Blue max service line; installing multiple gate valves (60 each) throughout system to allow isolation of leak sections; installing master meters throughout system to allow isolation and calculation of leaks; (iv) begin G.P.S. of the system; and (v) construction of new office building to include drive thru window and emergency generator.
