The Monroe County Conservation District is pound to provide financial and schrictical assistance to the lendowners of Monroe County. The Monroe County Conservation District was organized to plan and carry out a program of soil and water conservation on all lend within the county. The District receives financial assistance from the Kentucky Division of Conservation and the Monroe County Piscal Court and is presently operating within its budget. The Monroe County Conservation District remains a member in good standing with both the Kentucky and National Association of Conservation Districts. The Conservation District has representation the State and National meetings. The county-wide conservation program is administered by seven supervisors at meetings held once a month. The meetings are held the 2nd Westnesday of each month at 1:00 pm. at our office on 201 W. Paige St., Tompkinsville, KY and are open to tree public.

The Monroe County Conservation District is planning to apply for the CAIP program and will hold a meeting to discuss the upcoming program with producers. This program enables a wide variety of practices on a 50/50 cost share basis. These practices include Hay Storage, Fencing, Welter Tanks, Handling Facilities, Pasture Renovation, Cattle Genetics and Technology, The money is divided equally amongst all that participate in the program The CAIP program has brought over 5.3 million dollars into our county and provided much needed assistance in these areas. We will have an enrouncement in the newspeper, on our facebook page and by electronic billiboard with all the sign-up information and dates.

The Monroe County Conservation District aids producers in state cost share funding for va ous projects. Feel free to drop by the office for any of your conservation questions or needs. Our stall is available to assist you with conservation needs and ad in sign-up for funding on available programs. State Cost Share and EOIP are continuous sign-ups throughout the year. These programs address your conservation resource concerns and allow funding assistance thru one

On 8/28/2019 at 8:50 a.m. I received an e-mail from Penny Pickerell (MCWD) with an attached document for publication in the Tompkinsville News. The attached document was a corrected version of a previous document that was scheduled to be published for three consecutive weeks, August 29, September 5, and September 12. Despite being just a few hours away from uploading to our printer we were able to submit the corrected version into our publication for August 29, 2019. The correct notice was also then published on September 5.

It was brought to my attention on Monday, September 23 that the notice which we published on September 12 was in fact the original version and not the corrected one. I would like to apologize for this error on the part of Monroe County Press/Tompkinsville News. We have placed the correct notice for publication in this week's edition of the Tompkinsville News being published on Thursday, September 26, at our own expense. Please know that we are aware of the importance of the timing involved in publishing public notices. I would like to offer by way of an explanation, that on the evening of August 20, our news office experienced a direct lightning strike. This resulted in the loss of over \$100k in equipment including our entire phone system, network server, multiple computers, etc. In the weeks following we have managed to get our publication to print, however it has been done under extreme circumstances and not at all within our normal operating procedures.
