Full details such as the cause Contractor was digging a storm drain ditch and broke a 2" main PE with a excavator. KFG construction crew has leak controlled within 45 minutes by squeeze off which resulted in the loss of 14 customers gas service. The

crew replaced the area of the break with pretested 2" PE and EF couplings. Field technicians then went around and restored service to affected customers or left door tags if they were not home. T and N construction crew did not call 811 for this area but was aware that there were lines in the general area of the dig.
