#### NOTICE OF SATISFACTION OF COMPLAINT

Now comes the Defendant, Kentucky-American Water Company ("KAW"), and hereby provides notice of its satisfaction of Complainant's October 1, 2019 Complaint in this matter. The gist of the Complaint is that KAW used an incorrect or incomplete usage period to calculate estimated water usage during a period when the subject water meter was not operating correctly because it was "stuck," meaning it was not registering any water usage. Since the case was filed in October 2019, KAW has been able to observe Complainant's water usage for nearly two years with a properly functioning meter. That new data coupled with the continued expenditure of KAW's internal and external resources that would be required to litigate this matter led to negotiations between counsel for KAW and counsel for Complainant. Those negotiations resulted in KAW's agreement to satisfy the Complaint by agreeing to accept less than what KAW originally said was owed. In other words, KAW satisfied the Complaint by considering different usage periods. The parties reached this mutual agreement in full satisfaction of the Complaint. Therefore, Complainant filed its August 18, 2021 Motion to Dismiss by which it informed the Commission that an agreed resolution had been reached with KAW and that the case should be

dismissed with prejudice. KAW agrees with Complainant's Motion to Dismiss and hereby likewise agrees that this case should be dismissed and removed from the Commission's active docket.
