COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO ATMOS ENERGY CORPORATION

Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the following information on or before April 10, 2020. The Commission directs to the Commission's March 16, 2020 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding the filing of physical documents with the Commission. The Commission expects that original documents will be filed with the Commission within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency.²

Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity

that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Atmos shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Atmos fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Atmos shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to Atmos's response to Commission Staff's First Request (Staff's First Request), Item 4. Provide a general explanation, with as much non-confidential information as possible, demonstrating that the special contract with the industrial customer will generate sufficient revenue to cover Atmos's variable costs and contribute to fixed costs.

2. Refer to Atmos's response to Staff's First Request, Item 5.

- a. If additional investment is necessary to serve the industrial customer in the future, explain whether Atmos would require the customer to be responsible for the additional investment.

b. Further, explain whether Atmos would enter into a new contract with the industrial customer regarding the additional investment.
