<u>ORDER</u>

Farmdale Water District (Farmdale District) is hereby notified that it has been named as a Defendant in a formal complaint (Complaint) filed on June 15, 2020, a copy of which is attached to this Order as Attachment 1.

In the Complaint, the Complainant, William H. May, Jr., alleged that Farmdale District, in the course of working on its system, damaged his yard and did not repair the damage. Mr. May requests that Farmdale District repair his property to the state it was in before it was damaged.

On July 22, 2020, Farmdale District filed a letter indicating that this Complaint may have been settled, a copy of which is attached as Attachment 2. Clifford Toles, the chairman of Farmdale District's board of commissioners, stated in the letter that Farmdale District had repaired Mr. May's yard.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20(3)(a), the Commission, upon the filing of a formal complaint, shall examine if the complaint establishes a prima facie case. If the

Commission determines that the complaint does not establish a prima facie case, then the Commission shall give the Complainant an opportunity to amend the complaint so that it states a prima facie case. If Farmdale District has repaired Mr. May's property to his satisfaction, then his Complaint may not state a prima facie case, or otherwise request relief that the Commission can provide.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that Mr. May should file a statement within ten days of service of this Order to confirm whether this matter has been resolved.

Should documents of any kind be filed with the Commission in the course of this proceeding, the documents shall also be served on all parties of record. A party filing a paper containing personal information shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read. The Commission directs the parties to the Commission's March 16, 2020 Order and the March 24, 2020 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding the filing of physical documents with the Commission. In the March 16, 2020 Order, the Commission stated that if a non-electronic case is not converted to an electronic case, the Commission will grant a deviation from the filing requirements 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7(1), insofar that a filer may file one original document with no copies, or send an electronic mail message with an electronic copy of the document to the Commission and to parties to the matter. The Commission expects that original documents will be filed with the Commission within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency. Any electronic email filed in this manner should be sent to this email: PSCED@ky.gov. Each message should include the

case number in the subject line of the message and a read receipt to ensure the Commission received the message and documents. If electronic mail is used, please limit the size of the documents to 5 MB. All responses in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that within ten days of the date of service of this Order, Mr. May shall file a statement with the Commission to indicate whether this matter has been resolved.
