<u>O R D E R</u>

On June 23, 2020, the Commission Staff issued to several utilities requests for information, seeking information regarding the effect the current state of emergency caused by the global pandemic has had on each utility's operations. Responses to the requests are due on or before July 7, 2020.

Several utilities from whom information was requested have filed for an extension of time in which to respond to the requests.¹ Grounds for the various motions cite, *inter alia*, the three-day holiday preceding the current due date for responses and personnel availability to compile the requested information.

Based on the various motions and the likelihood that many utilities are under the same or similar constraints, the Commission finds that the deadline should be extended for the filing of all responses to the requests for information. Utilities are encouraged, however, to file their responses as soon as possible.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that responses to the Commission Staff's requests for information issued on June 23, 2020, shall be due on July 21, 2020.
