ORDER

On August 10, 2020, Sentra Corporation (Sentra) advised the Commission of its acceptance of the amount of revenue increase set forth in the Commission Staff Report (Staff Report) issued July 28, 2020. With its comments accepting Staff's calculated rates, Sentra requested an informal conference be held in order to discuss with Staff the calculations in the Staff Report. On September 2, 2020 a video informal conference was held. Pursuant to the Commission's Orders in Case No. 2020-00085,¹ issued March 16, 2020, and March 24, 2020, Sentra SHALL NOT FILE the original paper copy at this time, but rather shall file original paper copy within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency.

Having reviewed Sentra's August 10, 2020 comments to the Staff Report and all other relevant information, the Commission finds that:

1. Within 14 days from the date of this Order, Sentra should publish a one-time notice following the requirements of 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5. The customer notice should be formatted as set forth in the Appendix to this Order.

2. Sentra should provide proof of publication of the notice to the Commission no later than October 27, 2020.

3. Any motion to intervene based on Sentra's acceptance of the revenue requirement proposed in the Staff Report should be filed within 30 days after the date of publication of customer notice.

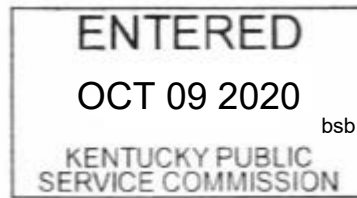
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Within 14 days from the date of this Order, Sentra shall publish a one-time notice following the requirements of 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5. The customer notice shall be formatted as set forth in the Appendix to this Order.

2. Sentra shall provide proof of publication of the notice to the Commission no later than October 27, 2020.

3. Any motion to intervene based on Sentra's acceptance of the revenue requirement proposed in the Staff Report shall be filed within 30 days of the date of publication of customer notice.

NOTICE

On April 14, 2020, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Sentra Corporation's (Sentra) application requesting to increase its revenue from natural gas sales by approximately 74.70 percent. After performing a review of Sentra's application and records, the PSC Staff recommended that Sentra be granted an increase in natural gas service revenues of approximately 118.27 percent. Pursuant to the PSC's Order of April 27, 2020, in Case No. 2020-00102, Sentra requested that the PSC approve the PSC Staff recommended revenue requirement and that Sentra be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:
