APPLICATION

The Applicant, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), respectfully states as follows:

- The Post Office address of the principal office of Applicant is 220 West Main Street,
 Louisville, Kentucky 40202. KU is a Kentucky corporation authorized to do business in the
 Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- 2. KU is a utility engaged in the business of supplying electric service in and to various cities and the inhabitants thereof within the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and has conducted such business for a number of years. The instant filing is made in accordance with Section 278.020(5) of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.
- 3. Receipt of the requested certificate will allow KU to pursue its bid on a new franchise for which the City of Taylorsville, Kentucky (the "City") has solicited bids pursuant to resolution or ordinance and advertisement, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 4. KU was incorporated in Kentucky on August 17, 1912, and in Virginia on November 26, 1991 (and effective as of December 1, 1991), and is in good standing in Kentucky and Virginia. A copy of KU's good standing certificate in Kentucky is attached as Exhibit B to this Application. KU can be reached at the email addresses of the counsel listed below.

- 5. There is and will continue to be a demand and need for electric service in the areas of the City subject to the franchise, and KU desires to obtain a franchise in accordance with the bidding protocol established by the City.
- 6. Should KU be successful in acquiring said franchise, it will file copies thereof with the Commission.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Utilities Company asks that the Commission enter an Order granting to KU a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to bid for and acquire a franchise from the City on or before May 12, 2020.

COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE SPENCER COUNTY, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 405

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE, **SPENCER** COUNTY KENTUCKY. CREATING FRANCHISE FOR THE ERECTION, LAYING **MAINTENANCE** OF **ELECTRIC FACILITIES** APPURENANT FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT IN, ALONG AND ACROSS THE PUBLIC WAYS, ROADS, STREETS, ALLEYS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE, KENTUCKY: FOR FURNISHING AND SELLING ELECTICITY BY MEANS OF SAID FACILITIES; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF SAID FRANCHISE.

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville ("City") wishes to ensure that electric service continues to be furnished to its citizens in a reliable and efficient manner:

WHEREAS, the City is aware that the provision of such service requires the continued use of public streets, ways, alleys and other public places;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 163 and 164 of the Kentucky Constitution and KRS 96.010, et seq., the City wishes to provide for the sale of a franchise for electrical service for the benefit of its citizenry;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>.A non-exclusive franchise ("Franchise") to use the City's public rights-of-way, as described in the Franchise Agreement attached to this Ordinance, is hereby created for providing electrical service within the City of Taylorsville, for a period of 20 years and a franchise fee of at least 3% of the gross receipts from the sale of electricity for consumption within the franchisee's territory within the City of Taylorsville, provided, however, as to be setforth the Franchise

Agreement, the franchise fee may be revised and amended every 5 years from the date of the Franchise Agreement;

Section 2. The Franchise created by this Ordinance shall be bid in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and Chapter 424 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, as well as any applicable City ordinances.

Section 3. The Franchise created by this Ordinance shall be awarded to the highest and best bidder, as shall be determined by the City in its sole discretion. In awarding the Franchise, the City shall consider the technical, managerial, and financial qualifications of the bidder to perform its obligations under the Franchise.

Section 4. The winning bidder and the City shall negotiate, execute and be bound by a Franchise Agreement with terms identical to, or substantially identical to, the Franchise Agreement referenced in Section 1 above and attached hereto, such Agreement to contain terms "that are fair and reasonable to the City, to the purchaser of the Franchise and to the patrons of the utility" (KRS Section 96.010). Such Franchise Agreement shall take effect no earlier than 90 days after its execution, to allow the City and the winning bidder to develop appropriate procedures for identifying and reviewing the electrical-consuming entities within the City's corporate limits.

<u>Section 5</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance or the attached Franchise Agreement be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance or the attached Franchise Agreement, as applicable.

Section 7. Time is of the essence in carrying out the terms and the provisions of this Ordinance and the Franchise created herein.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication.

COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE, SPENCER COUNTY, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 406

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION OF ELECTED OFFICIALS FOR THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE, KENTUCKY, PURSUANT TO KRS 83A.070(1).

WHEREAS, KRS 83A.070(1) provides that the legislative body of each city shall by ordinance, fix the compensation for each elected official not later than the first Monday in May in the year in which the officer is elected and whereas 2020 is the election year for the City Commissioners for the City of Taylorsville, the Mayor having been elected in 2018 for a four year term and who's compensation was set by Ordinance #383 in 2018.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Taylorsville that the annual compensation for each Commissioner for the City of Taylorsville shall be \$8,670.00 per year, during the Commissioner's two year term of office Aforesaid compensation shall be prorated and paid monthly beginning January 1, 2021.

The aforesaid compensation is subject to the annual cost of living adjustments that shall be made pursuant to KRS 83A,075.

Any Ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.


