Case No. 2020-00174 - Filing Deficiencies

The Commission Staff has reviewed the application in the above case. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

Filing deficiencies pursuant to:

- (1) <u>807 KAR 5:001 Section 16(4)(n):</u> A summary of the utility's latest depreciation study with schedules by major plant accounts, except that telecommunications utilities that have adopted the commission's average depreciation rates shall provide a schedule that identifies the current and test period depreciation rates used by major plant accounts. If the required information has been filed in another commission case, a reference to that case's number shall be sufficient; the specific filing deficiency is that the Application referred to Orders entered by the Commission and not to specific schedules that contain the required information set forth in this regulation.
- (2) <u>807 KAR 5:001 Section 16(5) (d):</u> The operating budget for each month of the period encompassing the pro forma adjustments; the specific filing deficiency is that the Application did not include this information.
- (3) <u>807 KAR 5:001 Section 16(5)(e):</u> The number of customers to be added to the test period end level of customers and the related revenue requirements impact for all pro forma adjustments with complete details and supporting work papers; The specific filing deficiency is that the Application did not include this information.
- (4) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(4)(c): The amount of the change requested in both dollar amounts and percentage change for each customer classification to which the proposed rates will apply; The specific filing deficiency is that both the abbreviated and full notice provided the impact on average monthly bill for each customer class with annual and monthly increase in dollar amounts and percentage change, which is consistent with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(4)(d), but does not contain the information required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(4)(c).



You are requested to submit the information necessary to cure the deficiencies within 10 days of the date of this letter.
