- Reviewed an email Mr. Hodge sent on Saturday, 9/5/2020 that showed a dig ticket, however it was requested on June 3, expired on June 24, and the damage occurred on August 28, 65 days after expiration. I sent Mr. Hodge an email with this information.

September 15, 2020

- · Sent Mr. Hodges an email about resolution.
- Received an email back requesting a telephone call.

September 16, 2020

 Called Mr. Hodges back at 270.230.6734, long discussions, I believe Mr. Hodges wants the demand letter with the reduced penalty and remedial. This is what I will send.

VIOLATION

KRS 367.4911 (1) (a) Each excavator, or person responsible for an excavation, planning excavation or demolition work shall, not less than two (2) full working days nor more than ten (10) full working days prior to commencing work, notify each affected operator of the excavator's intended work and work schedule. Contacting the applicable protection notification centers shall satisfy this requirement.

KRS 367.4911 (10) When excavation or demolition is necessary within the approximate location of the underground facility, the excavator shall hand-dig or use nonintrusive means to avoid damage to the underground facility.

The information I have is that Warren Rural Electric requested a dig ticket for 387 Oak Wood Ln in Elizabethtown on July 6, 2020, in order to replace a pole. This would explain marks on the ground, but doesn't necessarily include the scope of where you were digging. As you can see, the identification of the dig tickets are 10-digit numbers, in this case 2006261333, not letters.

So the documentation I have indicates that this is a violation of the statutes, KRS 367.4911 (1) (a) for not having a dig ticket, and KRS 367.4911 (10) for digging with mechanized equipment within 18-inches of locate marks.

There are three possible ways to resolve this violation.

- 1. Since it is your first violation, and you were the homeowner, if you will agree to participate in a damage prevention training that the PSC puts on, we will reduce the initial \$500 civil penalty to \$100. Currently we do not know when we may be able to conduct the training due to the coronavirus pandemic, however we are exploring the ability to conduct the training online, which would save you a trip to Frankfort;
- 2. No participation in the training would be required, but the full \$500 civil penalty would be due; and
- 3. You have the right to request a hearing before the Public Service Commissioners.

Please let me know which option you would prefer.


