Supplemental Request for Information to Russellville Solar LLC

Please consider the following the Supplemental Written Request for information to Russellville Solar, LLC, following the order entered by the Kentucky Public Service Commission dated 3/17/22, and the attached appendix. Based on the responses submitted by Russellville Solar LLC, it is clear that the Public Service Commission needs to halt this project immediately. Showing graphs and charts that are 2 years old is useless data and not relevant. The questions presented were not answered and showed no basis for benefitting Logan County. Taking prime farm land out of agriculture production is going to destroy our county and the people who live here. Russellville Solar LLC has given no basis for how or why this will benefit Logan County. No maintenance plan was presented, no decommissioning plan was presented and no plan to care for the artifacts or the Cherokee Nation. Several out of state companies have been seen on the properties in the past couple of months. Wheat fields have been destroyed without the owner's knowledge. These actions show that no local people will be hired and Russellville Solar LLC does not know the value of the crops nor the land in question.

Please stop this project from moving forward and destroying prime farm land that will never be able to be used for farming ever again. This is important to our county and its citizens. We care for the land, take care of the land and love the land that was provided for us. It would be a crime to destroy this agriculture land for solar farms.

Also as the Kentucky Public Service Commission is to protect the interests of the citizens of Kentucky, a lot of the energy generated by this proposed site is going to a company with facilities in Sumner, County, Tennessee. Benefiting this county in Tennessee doesn't seem to me to be benefitting the citizens of Logan County, Kentucky in any way.
