This matter arises from a complaint filed by Rosemary Spicer against Jackson Energy alleging, in sum, that Jackson Energy has refused to provide electric service to a structure on her property. Jackson Energy responded to the complaint in a timely manner and noted that it was unable to provide the service inasmuch as Ms. Spicer's wastewater disposal system did not comply with local regulations and therefore, the appropriate release originally granted by the Kentucky River District Health Department had been revoked.

On September 2, 2021, the Commission entered an order directing Ms. Spicer to file a response to Jackson Energy's answer and further directing her to provide documentation from the Kentucky River District Health Department documenting that the

Thanks for contacting this office in regards to a proposed electrical hookup for a residential structure located near 1861 Pine Grove Road in Lee County. It has been brought to this office's attention that a release had been given for permanent power by the Lee County Health Department. After speaking with the owner, Ms. Rosemary Spicer, this office wishes to rescind the release for permanent power dated for April 29, 2021. The reason for this being that Ms. Spicer has an intent to use a wastewater disposal system that is not in accordance with KRS statutes relating to the KY Onsite Sewage Regulations. Also, in accordance with KY Division of Plumbing basic principles all dwellings must have minimum fixture requirements that must be connected to an approved wastewater disposal system.
