The Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) has recently opened the above case as an investigation into the impact of Madison County Fiscal Court's use of the Madison County Utility District's (MCUD) system for its fiber optic cable installation project.

This investigation stemmed from questions raised during Case No. 2021-00218, MCUD's application for an alternative rate adjustment. It appears from information provided in response to data requests provided in Case No. 2021-00218 the personnel from the Division of Water (DOW) met with Madison County representatives, but that a detailed review of the hydraulic impact of the project was not undertaken by the DOW. The PSC has requested additional information from MCUD that would include a hydraulic analysis of the impact of the project. The PSC would appreciate it if the DOW would be able to provide technical assistance through an evaluation of the hydraulic analysis of the project if it is available.
