#### OPENING ORDER

Watson Farms LLC (Watson Farms) has been named as a party to an investigation before the Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission) for allegedly violating the Kentucky Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act (Act).<sup>1</sup>

Pursuant to KRS 278.495(2), the Commission has jurisdiction to regulate the safety of natural gas facilities in Kentucky and to enforce minimum federal pipeline safety standards. Under the Act, the Commission has authority to investigate and assess civil penalties for any violation of the Act that results in excavation damage to an underground facility used to transport natural gas or hazardous liquid subject to federal pipeline safety laws, 49 U.S.C. § 60101, *et seq.* Any person who violates any provision of the Act is subject to assessment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$250 for the first offense, no more than \$1,000 for the second offense within one year, and no more than \$3,000 for the third and any subsequent offense. Additionally, any person whose violation of the Act results in damage to an underground facility containing any flammable, toxic, corrosive,

or hazardous material or results in the release of any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material is subject to an additional penalty of up to \$1,000.

Following receipt of a report of excavation damage to its underground gas pipeline from an operator, Commission Staff (Staff) conducted an investigation and prepared an Incident Report, a copy of which is attached to this Order as an Appendix. In its Incident Report, Staff cites Watson Farms for violation of the following provision of the Act:

> KRS 367.4911(1)(a) – Each excavator, or person responsible for an excavation, planning excavation or demolition work shall, not less than two (2) full working days nor more than ten (10) full working days prior to commencing work, notify each affected operator of the excavator's intended work and work schedule. Contacting the applicable protection notification centers shall satisfy this requirement.

Based on its review of the Incident Report and being otherwise sufficiently advised,

the Commission finds prima facie evidence that Watson Farms violated the Underground

Facility Damage Prevention Act. The Commission further finds that a formal investigation

into the excavation damage incident should be conducted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Watson Farms shall submit to the Commission, via email sent to <u>PSCED@ky.gov</u> with the case number of this proceeding in the subject line of the message, a written response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report within 20 days of receipt of this Order.

2. Any partnership, corporation, or business entity (including a limited liability company) must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Kentucky, and such representation includes the filing of papers with and appearances at hearings before the Commission.

3. An individual may submit a response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report without the representation of an attorney.

4. The Staff Incident Report 43112 in the Appendix to this Order is made a part of the record in this case.

5. Please note that notice of a hearing to be held in this matter will be mailed to Watson Farms once proof of service is received by the Commission. Parties who fail to appear after service will be subject to entry of a default judgment against them.

The Operator reports that the Excavator damaged a below ground riser, demolishing a home, with a track hoe, the roof and wall fell on the riser and the Excavator failed to contact the KY Contact Center (811). **The DR is included as Attachment 1.** 

#### INVESTIGATION

#### On 10/12/21:

An attempt to contact the Excavator at 270-625-2521 resulted in speaking to an individual indicating that he was with Watson Farms and demolition occur on the incident date at the incident location. He stated that he had no idea if a call was made to 811 prior to the excavation and research was warranted. When inquiring how long it would take, he stated, "a month or so". Staff informed the individual that this was insufficient and a week would be sufficient and the conversation ended before inquires could be made as to whom was speaking. A call back to obtain a name resulted in no answer. *Note:* A reverse look up of 270-625-2521 revealed the number is assigned to Jason Emery.

A web search for Watson Farms provided a telephone number for Charles A Watson Farm / Watson Excavating, 270-365-2358 address 444 Grooms Ln., Princeton, KY 42445, wherein Charlie Watson was contacted. Mr. Watson stated that he was contracted for payment to demolish church property and the pastor indicated to him all utilities were shut off. Mr. Watson stated that no call was made to 811 and there was no need due to no excavation occurring. Staff informed Mr. Watson of KRS 367.4911(1) (a) and the need to call 811 prior to all demolitions. Mr. Watson stated that he has been doing demolition for 50+ yrs. (approximately 1,000 demolitions) and he has, "never heard of such", felt the state was over regulating and wanting money. Mr. Watson was informed of his options and never indicated which he would take, therefore Staff informed Mr. Watson a Demand Letter offering the Damage Prevention Course to receive the reduced penalty of \$250.00 would be forthcoming.


