Dear Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet,

On August 15, 2022, Sebree Solar II LLC ("Sebree Solar II") received a request by the Mayor of Robards, Kentucky to hold a public meeting in response to the proposed construction of the 150 MW Sebree Solar II facility for the generation of electricity within Henderson County, Kentucky. In accordance with KRS 278.704, Section 9, the merchant electric generating entity or a person acting on behalf of a merchant electric generating entity shall, on or before the date of the public meeting held under subsection (6) shall provide notice of all research, testing, or any other activities being planned or considered to:
