ORDER

On September 27, 2022, the Commission issued an Order granting Garrard County Water Association, Inc. (Garrard County Water) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to construct a water main and storage tank, approving the proposed plan for financing the project, and approving rate changes required by its agreement with the United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development (RD). The Order included the following requirement: “On or before June 30, 2023, Garrard County Water shall provide a copy of its revenue sufficiency report for the year ended December 31, 2022, and any board meeting minutes that report the board’s decision on the need for a rate application.”<sup>1</sup> The Commission ordered that filing in lieu of requiring Garrard County Water to file a rate case, despite recurring operating losses, because Garrard County Water had developed a Rate Sufficiency Review Policy

in Case 2021-00350.<sup>2</sup> Garrard County Water has not filed a revenue sufficiency report or related documentation.

The Commission, on its own motion, finds that this proceeding should be reopened for the purpose of addressing Garrard County Water's failure to file its revenue sufficiency report. The Commission further finds that Garrard County Water should file into the record of this proceeding a copy of its revenue sufficiency report for the year ended December 31, 2022, and any board meeting minutes that report the board's decision on the need for a rate application within 30 days of the service of this Order. Garrard County Water should also explain why it has not filed the required documents.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. This case is reopened.
2. Within 30 days of the service of this Order, Garrard County Water shall file a copy of its revenue sufficiency report for the year ended December 31, 2022, and any board meeting minutes that report the board's decision on the need for a rate application.
3. Within 30 days of the service of this Order, Garrard County Water shall provide an explanation why it did not timely file the required documents.

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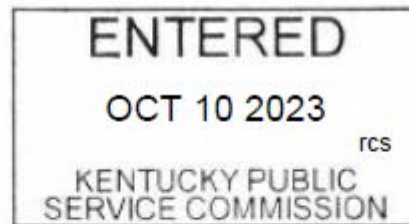
