I am highly concerned regarding the proposed rate hikes and am hopeful that the settlement will be approved to ensure that low to moderate income users do not disproportionately suffer. As you know, KY Power's investor-owned residential customers already pay the highest average monthly bill in the state at \$187.56 according to a state report published this summer. However, the rate reduction doesn't do enough to mitigate the financial burden many in Eastern Kentucky face. I appreciate the additional incentives that KY Power plans to provide, but more investments in energy efficiency will be needed to avoid higher usage especially in the Ashland area. Thank you for considering these comments and thank you for working to make our utilities more affordable.
