(c) That:

On March 3, 2023, our house electrical system and appliances were back fed high voltage from the overhead main transmission line. This resulted in the main panel bus bar and all GFI breakers being damaged. All GFI outlets have been destroyed as well as some lighting fixtures, and the majority of all major appliances including the furnace. This is the FOURTH time in the past seven (7) years that this has occurred. On the 3rd incident, Kentucky Utilities determined that they had not installed proper spacing between the upper and lower wires and supposedly corrected the situation. After the 4th major loss, we have no reason to believe that issue has been corrected. It has created a possible safety issue in our home.

There are approximately 14 or 15 other houses that are on the same KU electric line; some have reported similar issues. We need to get this resolved immediately.

WHEREFORE, complainant asks for access to safe and reliable electricity.

The relief preferred would be to have Owen Rural Electric provide the electric service to the Brown farm (243 Vera Cruz Lane) at KU's expense. It would be hard to have any faith in KU after a fourth fire ball surge in the Brown home.

The relief desired includes being made whole with payment of damages including restitution for lost property and expenses incurred.
