SITING BOARD STAFF'S POST-HEARING REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO BANJO CREEK SOLAR LLC

Banjo Creek Solar, LLC (Banjo Creek), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on February 2, 2024. The Siting Board directs Banjo Creek to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the

person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Banjo Creek shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Banjo Creek obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Banjo Creek fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Banjo Creek shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Banjo Creek shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Provide a specific list of the species of vegetation, including trees, to be planted as part of the vegetation screening. Identify which are native and which are evergreen.
2. Provide a list of native pollinators to be used in the vegetative screening.
3. Provide the following information:

a. The distances between the fence surrounding the proposed solar facility and the adjacent property lines;

b. The approximate distance between the fence surrounding the proposed solar facility and the front doors of adjacent residences;

c. The distances between the panels and property lines of adjacent parcels;

d. The approximate distances between the panels and the front doors of adjacent residences;

e. The distances between the inverters and the property lines of adjacent parcels;

f. The approximate distances between the inverters and the front doors of adjacent residences;

g. The distance between the proposed substation and the nearest residence;

h. The distances between the proposed substation and the property lines of adjacent parcels.

4. Provide Glennmont Solar Development IV's legal name and identify whether it is a subsidiary of any other company. If it is a subsidiary, provide the legal name of the parent company and place of incorporation or registration.

5. Provide the environmental compliance record for Glennmont Solar Development IV and any parent company.

6. Explain whether the leases with the participating landowners contain decommissioning obligations for the removal of all underground cabling and equipment.

7. Provide a list of GreenGo Energy developed projects in operation in the United States, including an address and a length of operation as of January 23, 2024.

8. Provide both studies, not yet submitted in the record, referenced by witness Jonathan Flemings in his testimony.

10. Explain EPC's business relationship to Banjo Creek and include any contract, if applicable.

11. Provide the endangered species list for Kentucky and identify which species are likely to be found in proposed project area.

12. Provide the entire corporate structure, or membership interests, of Banjo Creek.

13. Provide the entire corporate structure of GreenGo Energy.

14. Refer to the Application, part 11, paragraph 2. Provide the entities with an ownership interest in Banjo Creek that were referenced as not having any environmental violations.
