While the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) claims the facilities are safe, the US Department of Interior states that "electromagnetic radiation standards used by the FCC continue to be based on thermal heating, a criterion nearly 30 years out of date and inapplicable today." Other countries now limit public exposure to levels far lower than the standards set by the FCC.

The World Health Organization (WHO) classified the type of radiation emitted by cell towers as a Class 2B carcinogen, meaning possible carcinogen to humans, the same as lead and DDT.
