Comes now, Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation ("Jackson Purchase" or the "Company"), pursuant to KRS 278.020, 807 KAR 5:001, and other applicable law, and hereby respectfully requests from the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") an Order granting Jackson Purchase a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") for approval to install a new Advanced Metering Infrastructure System ("AMI"). 1. Jackson Purchase is a not-for-profit, member-owned, rural electric distribution cooperative organized under KRS Chapter 279. Jackson Purchase is engaged in the business of distributing retail electric power to approximately 30,000 meters for approximately 23,000 members in Ballard, Carlisle, Graves, Livingston, Marshall, and McCracken counties in Kentucky.
