To the Kentucky Public Service Commission,

Joy and Matthew Lee respectfully submit this response regarding the above-referenced matter.

We wish to clarify that we are not attorneys and do not intend to retain legal counsel to pursue this complaint further. Our purpose in filing was to make the Commission aware of what we believe to be improper and fraudulent actions by Farmdale Water District. We trust that it is within the Commission's authority and responsibility to review the evidence and determine what, if any, action is warranted.

We have already provided documentation supporting our concerns, including copies of text messages demonstrating unprofessional conduct by Scott Woolridge, specifically related to overseeing construction activities that resulted in our private water line being cut without our knowledge or permission. Additionally, the Commission has access to Farmdale Water District records that reflect the extended delay in transferring water service into our names and the improper billing we experienced, including being charged for multiple properties that were not ours.

We believe the existing documentation is sufficient to establish the facts of this matter. Furthermore, the Commission has the ability to audit the accounts of the Lees, the Mehaffys, and the Hills to verify the periods during which we were paying water bills while others were not. You should have the authority to take neighbors statements as well.

At this time, we have no additional evidence to submit and no further statements to provide. We have fulfilled our role by filing the complaint and supplying supporting materials. We no longer have confidence in the integrity of Farmdale Water District, and we leave this matter entirely in the hands of the Commission.

We respectfully request that any further investigation or action taken by the Commission be handled independently and without adverse impact to us, as the damages we have experienced have already occurred.
