I do not approve. Please deny their request along with LG&E's request. Everyone knows they are cutting deals with the massive data centers being built so home owners will be subsidizing them.

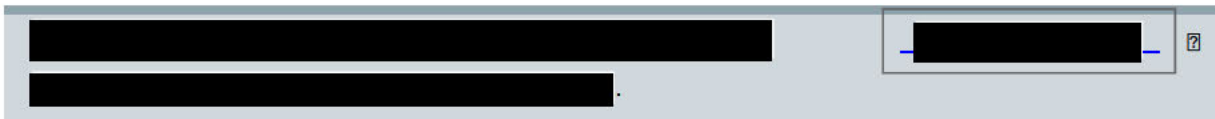

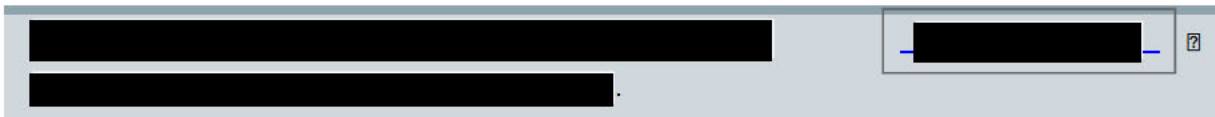
