Comments: I am reaching out as a concerned customer of LG&E/KU. The revenue for their parent company (PPL COMPANY) for 2024 was \$8.6 BILLION dollars, which was a 1.8% increase over last year (\$140 MILLION dollars). It is stated that 42% of that revenue comes from LG&E/KU. That is \$3.6 BILLION dollars in revenue. Any replacement of aging structures/equipment will be used as tax write-off incentives over the course of the next several years as depreciated value. The 11.5% rate increase is just a money grab. After all the equipment is replaced, they will not lower the rate at that point. Just for my household, this will be a \$50+ increase in our bill every single month. That is not something that we can afford and they have a monopoly on energy in Kentucky. What

ever our city uses, that's what we have to use. Please take this into consideration before granting any kind of rate increase. Thank You.
