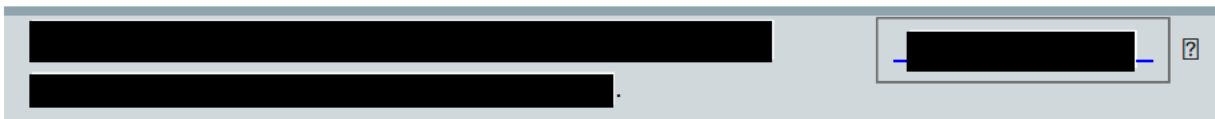

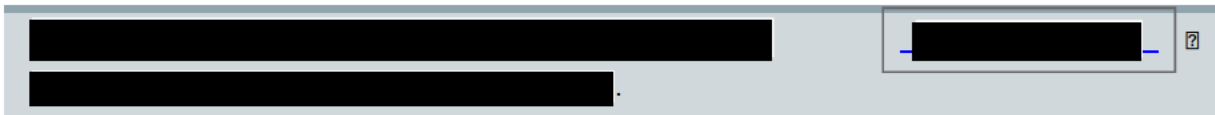

I am writing expressing concern with the proposed rate increase LG&E is requesting. The increase of 8.3% for Electrical and 14% for Natural Gas seems a bit extreme. Regarding the request for the electrical increase I realize we have had some unusual weather event that may effect the electrical infrastructure the LG&E spokes person mentioned on a story on WDRB that there are electrical poles that are over 100 years old that need to be replaced. It seems to me that there should have been a plan in place to upgrade the older infrastructure sometime over the last 50 years. It just seems that the blame is being placed on weather when it sounds like there was no plan in place over the last several years to address the aging poles and substations.

The price for Natural Gas appears to be lower that it was in 2017 and 2022 and i am not sure

why the large increase has been requested unless the problem has been poor planning.

As a retired individual asking for an increase of this amount seems to be unreasonable and a bit greedy.

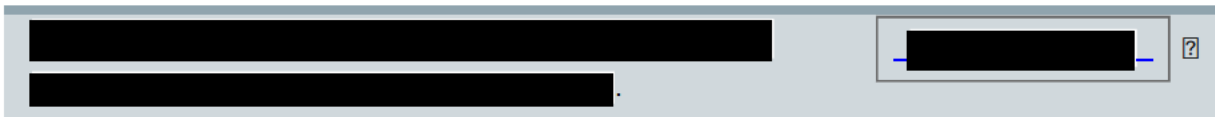
