ORDER

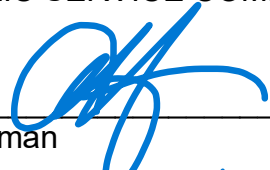
On May 21, 2025, BTS Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility (jointly, Joint Applicants) filed a notice of intent to file an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to construct and operate a wireless telecommunications facility in Bell County no later than July 31, 2025.

On October 14, 2025, Joint Applicants filed a motion to withdraw their notice and requested that the case be dismissed and removed from the Commission's docket because Joint Applicants no longer intended to file a CPCN application in this docket.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Joint Applicants' motion to withdraw their notice is granted.
2. This case is dismissed and removed from the Commission's docket.
