## ORDER

This matter arises upon the motion of the Kentucky Resources Council, Inc. (KRC) filed October 1, 2025, requesting full intervention. As a basis for its motion, KRC stated that it represented "low-income individuals, organizations, and communities across the Commonwealth on a range of environmental and energy-related matters." Those members include "numerous individuals who are citizens, ratepayers, and property owners across the Commonwealth." Additionally, KRC stated that the organization has "a long history of work on nuclear issues concerning the Commonwealth[.]"

# LEGAL STANDARD

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through the Office of Rate Intervention (Attorney General), has the statutory right to intervene in Commission cases pursuant to KRS 367.150(8)(b). The Attorney General was granted

full intervention on June 18, 2025.<sup>4</sup> With limited exception, intervention by all others is permissive and within the sole discretion of the Commission.<sup>5</sup>

The regulatory standard for permissive intervention, set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4, is twofold. Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11), requires a person to set forth in the motion to intervene either (1) a special interest in the proceeding that is not otherwise adequately represented in the case, or (2) that intervention is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings.

### DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

Based on a review of the pleadings at issue and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that KRC has demonstrated that KRC is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in considering this matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings for the reasons discussed below.

KRC's motion established that the organization has significant relevant experience to merit its intervention in this case. Specifically, KRC's motion highlighted its participation in a number of nuclear related matters, including enrichment, storage, and disposal of waste at the former Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant, storage of low-level radioactive waste at the Maxey Flats Disposal Site, and has participated in the legislative process since at least 1984.<sup>6</sup> Its participation included KRC's appointment to the Kentucky Energy Policy Advisory Board which worked to produce the Kentucky Electric

Generation and Transmission Siting Board.<sup>7</sup> Because KRC's motion clearly establishes that it is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, the Commission does not need to consider whether KRC also satisfies the special interest prong of the Commission's intervention regulation.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that KRC should be granted full rights of a party in this proceeding. The Commission directs KRC to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>8</sup> regarding filings with the Commission.

### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. KRC's motion to intervene is granted.
- 2. KRC is entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
- 3. KRC shall comply with all provisions of the Commission's regulations, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, related to the service and electronic filing of documents.
- 4. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(9), within seven days of service of this Order, KRC shall file a written statement with the Commission that:
- a. Certifies that it, or its agent, possesses the facilities to receive electronic transmissions; and
