ORDER

On September 30, 2025, Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos) filed a petition, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878, requesting that the Commission grant confidential treatment for an indefinite period for the following information contained in Atmos's Quarterly Gas Supply Clause filing:

- a. Exhibit D, page 5 of 6, contains confidential information from which the actual price being paid by Atmos for natural gas to its suppliers can be determined;
- b. Exhibit C, page 2 of 2, contains confidential information pertaining to prices projected to be paid by Atmos for purchase contracts;
- c. Invoices and monthly usage reports for each month of the reporting period;
- d. Purchases of sustainable natural gas from a renewable source during the reporting period identifying the supplier, cost, and amount.

While not described in the petition, Atmos attached to the petition recovery volume summary data for G-1 sales as shown on Exhibit D.4 of its Quarterly Gas Supply Clause filing. The purchase invoices and monthly usage information referenced in the petition were not attached to the petition but rather filed separately subject to the request for confidential treatment.

As a basis for its petition, Atmos asserted that public disclosure of this information would adversely impact Atmos's ability to negotiate future gas supply contracts at favorable prices and therefore would impair Atmos's ability to minimize the price of natural gas paid by Atmos's customers. For this reason, Atmos argued that public disclosure is prohibited under KRS. 61.878(1)(c)(1), which prohibits public disclosure of records that are confidential or proprietary that, if publicly disclosed, would result in competitive advantage to the discloser's competitors.

Having considered the petition and the material at issue, the Commission finds that the pricing and volume information subject to the petition is generally recognized as confidential or proprietary, and that public disclosure of the information could result in commercial harm to Atmos. The Commission finds that the information therefore meets the criteria for confidential treatment and is exempted from public disclosure pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878(1)(c)(1).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Atmos's September 30, 2025 petition for confidential treatment is granted.
2. The designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order shall not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection for an indefinite period or until further order of this Commission.
3. Use of the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order in any Commission proceeding shall comply with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(9).
4. If the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order becomes publicly available or no longer qualifies for confidential treatment, Atmos shall

inform the Commission and file with the Commission an unredacted copy of the designated material.

5. If a nonparty to this proceeding requests to inspect the material granted confidential treatment by this Order and the period during which the material has been granted confidential treatment has not expired, Atmos shall have 20 days from receipt of written notice of the request to demonstrate that the material still falls within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. If Atmos is unable to make such demonstration, the requested material shall be made available for inspection. Otherwise, the Commission shall deny the request for inspection.

6. The Commission shall not make the requested material available for inspection for 30 days from the date of service of an Order finding that the material no longer qualifies for confidential treatment in order to allow Atmos to seek a remedy afforded by law.

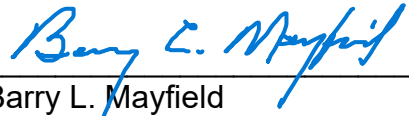
