Commission Staff acknowledges receipt of Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc.'s ("Duke Kentucky") request for leave to file its revised tariffs to continue its Home Energy Assistance ("HEA") program as authorized by the Commission in Case No. 2011-00109 on October 3, 2011.

On August 18, 2011, the Commission approved Duke Kentucky's application to extend its HEA program for a three-year period, from September 25, 2011 through September 24, 2014, and directed Duke Kentucky to file its revised tariffs for the HEA program within 20 days from the date of the Order, or no later than September 7, 2011.

Because of an inadvertent error, Duke Kentucky has not filed the revised tariffs and now seeks to file its revised tariffs, instanter, as the existing HEA tariffs are set to expire on September 30, 2011. The revised HEA tariffs are attached to Duke Kentucky's request. In support of its request, Duke Kentucky states that no parties have been harmed because of the inadvertent filing as the current tariffs have not yet expired.
