

TESTIMONY OF PETER CONRAD

Q1. Please state your name and position with the Henderson County Water District.

A. Peter Conrad, Superintendent of the Henderson County Water District ("HCWD").

Q2. What is your educational background?

A. I have a degree in History with a Minor in Political Science from the University of Southern Illinois, Carbondale.

Q3. What is your work experience?

A. I have been Superintendent of the HCWD since August 20, 2013. Prior to that I worked for the Green River Area Development District, Owensboro, KY, as the Infrastructure Planner; I held that position from June 2, 2009, until starting at HCWD. Prior to attending college, I worked installing cable television, telephone and natural gas lines for five (5) years.

Q4. Have you previously submitted testimony to the Kentucky Public Service Commission?

1 A. Yes.

2 Q5. What is the HCWD requesting in this case?

3 A. To amend the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to reflect the cost
4 of the 1,900 radio frequency meters at \$180.46 per meter.

5 Q6. What is the reason for the cost increase?

6 A. The vendor, Neptune Equipment Co. (NECO) has discontinued the model of the
7 approved meter (Model T10 R900i) and replaced it with "Neptune T10 Enhanced
8 V4 E-Coder®R900i, Pit" which will carry an additional cost of \$5.26 per meter.

10 Q7. Is the replacement model compatible with the existing HCWD system?

11 A. Yes.



1. The granting agency has not approved this as a single source
2. If the contract was awarded to a different vendor there would be compatibility issues and likely increased costs in maintaining multiple systems.
3. The initial bid went out and Neptune was the low bidder. The bid was awarded. When additional meters were needed, Neptune compatibility was specified. Neptune/NECO was the only bidder on the third lot that was bid. NO OTHER BRANDS APPEAR TO BE COMPATIBLE WITH OUR NEPTUNE SYSTEM.
4. Because of the unique attributes of the Neptune system, it is best that the Water District have a consistent radio read meter system and therefore, multiple vendors is unsatisfactory.



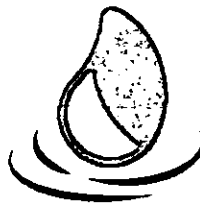
