
Listed below are the following steps we will take to shut down Richardsville Gas Company.

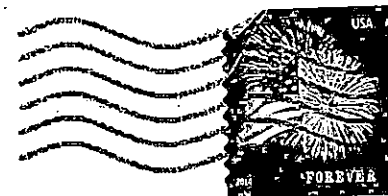

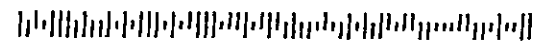

As most of you have already heard, the Public Service Commission of Kentucky has issued their ruling concerning their investigation to require Richardsville Gas Company Incorporated to cease operations. Per their ruling, we must cease operation by October 31, 2015. We must present them with a plan for disconnection and abandonment of the system within 20 days of their ruling.

To give our customers ample time to secure an alternative heating source, we plan to shut down the system the week of October 26-30, 2015.
