RE: Virtual Informal Conference (IC) of July 15, 2026

Pursuant to Orders issued in both Case Nos. 2025-00329 and 2025-00330 on July 13, 2026, a joint, virtual informal conference (IC) was conducted on July 15, 2026. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster for the Joint IC.

The purpose of the joint IC was to discuss aspects of the Commission's July 2, 2026 final Order in both cases pertaining to the information necessary for the Commission to fully evaluate the proposed transfers. This IC was scheduled at the request of Edmonson County Water District (Edmonson District), Green River Valley Water District (Green River Valley District), and Grayson County Water District (Grayson District) (collectively, the Parties) in their motions that were both filed on July 9, 2026.

Counsel represented each of the Joint Applicants for the IC. Joint Applicants confirmed that the motions filed in each case on July 9, 2026, did not request a rehearing, but only requested an IC for the time being. The Parties discussed the history of water utilities in their particular area of Kentucky and the issues that have affected Edmonson District in particular. The Parties further discussed the recent retirement of Edmonson District General Manager Kevin Shaw, but noted that he would continue at the utility for some time in a consulting role to assist the new General Manager. Counsel for Edmonson District stated that to the best of her knowledge, Edmonson District is not currently planning any other transfers or acquisitions of utility systems beyond what has been proposed in these cases and what is proposed in Case No. 2026-00136. Edmonson District confirmed that they have received several federal grants over the past few years including a federal grant in 2026 in the amount of approximately \$30 million. Staff asked some questions regarding whether the Parties had considered a merger and emphasized that a merger does not necessarily cost anything in and of itself, but is simply a way to structurally reorganize utilities.

Lastly, Staff discussed some of the financial topics the Parties could provide some clarity on. First, counsel for Green River District stated that its assumption of debt from Edmonson District would not have any impact on rates because USDA RD (RD) only considers it a transfer. Staff asked that Green River District file something into the record reflecting that the loan assumption would not affect Green River District's current rates and also provide any other updates from RD related to the loan transfer request. Second, Staff inquired into whether Grayson County or Edmonson District had communicated with

customers regarding the proposed transfer and any effect it would have on the customer rates for those customers being absorbed by Grayson District. Counsel for Grayson District said a letter had been sent to customers about the proposed transfer and that rates could be affected. Staff asked that Grayson District file into the record the letter it sent to customers regarding the proposed transfer. Third, Counsel for Green River Valley District stated it was happy to provide customer notice of the proposed rate increase to its customers but did not think it was required by statute or regulation. Staff stated that if the Commission desired notice, it would be reflected in a future Order. Lastly, counsel for Grayson District stated it was approved for the proposed KIA loan. However, Staff noted that there was no evidence in the application or in the case record reflecting that a KIA loan had been approved for Grayson District. Staff asked that Grayson District provide evidence of the approved KIA loan in the case record.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
