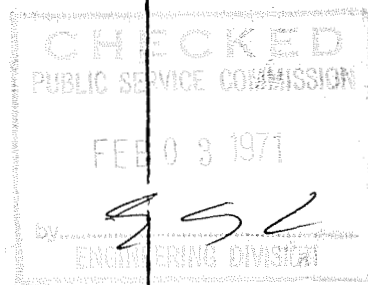

Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the member in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt-hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section in which case shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Conditions of Service

1. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.
2. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate. If a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit, the registrations of the two watt-hour meters shall be added to obtain total kilowatt-hours used and the registrations of the two demand meters shall be added to obtain the total kilowatt demand for billing purposes.
3. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, shall be considered the distribution system for the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
4. If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of ten per cent (10%) shall apply to the demand and energy

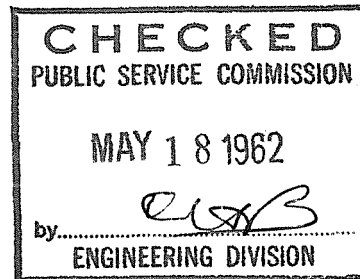

Power Factor Adjustment:

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Power factor may be measured at any time. Should such measurements indicated that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 85%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85% and divided by the per cent power factor.
