

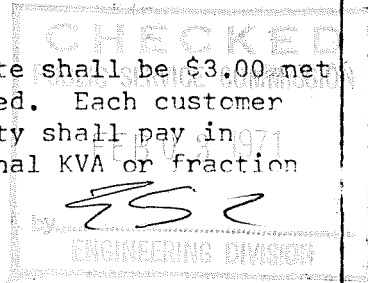

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$3.00 net where 5 KVA or less transformer capacity is required. Each customer who requires more than 5 KVA of transformer capacity shall pay in addition to the above minimum, 75¢ on each additional KVA or fraction thereof required.

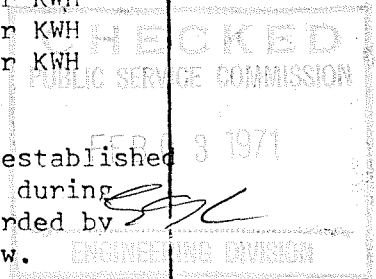

LARGE POWER - INDUSTRIAL

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Industrial Rate with transformer capacity of 5,000 KVA or over.

If service is frunished at primary distribution voltage, a discount shall apply to the demand and energy charge as follows:

- A. If the monthly kilowatt-hour usage is at least 150 times billing demand kilowatt a discount of 5% shall apply.
- B. If the monthly kilowatt-hour usage is at least 225 times billing demand kilowatts a discount of 7% shall apply.
- C. If the monthly kilowatt-hour usage is at least 300 times billing demand kilowatts a discount of 10% shall apply.

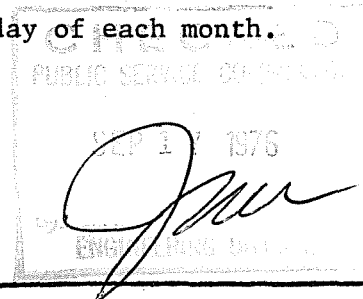

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. The Cooperative shall furnish, install, operate, and maintain the outdoor lighting equipment including lamp, luminaire, bracket attachment and control device on an existing secondary pole. Should the service required be other than by the above standard provisions, the Cooperative reserves the right to require payment from the consumer for the initial cost of such installation.
2. The lighting equipment shall remain the property of the Cooperative. The Consumer shall protect the lighting equipment from deliberate damage.
3. The Consumer shall allow authorized representatives of the Cooperative to enter upon the Consumer's premises and to trim trees and shrubs as necessary for maintenance of the lighting equipment and for removal of lighting equipment upon termination of service under this schedule.
4. The Cooperative and the Consumer shall execute an agreement for service under this schedule for a period of not less than one year.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The Customer's bill will be due on the first day of each month.
