AGREEMENT made _____ 19_____, between Inter-County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (hereinafter called the "Seller"), and _____ (hereinafter called the "Consumer") a Corporation, Partnership, Individual. (Strike inapplicable designations)

WITNESSETH:

The Seller agrees to sell and to deliver to the Consumer, and the Consumer agrees to purchase and receive from the Seller all of the electric power and energy which the Consumer may need at _____ up to _____ KVA, upon the following terms:

1. Service Characteristics

Service hereunder shall be alternating current _____ phase, sixty cycles, _____ volts.

2. Payment

a. The Consumer shall pay the Seller for service hereunder at the rates and upon the terms and conditions set forth in Rate Schedule made a part of this agreement. Notwithstanding any provision of the Schedule, however, the minimum charge per month shall be \$ _____.

b. Bills for service hereunder shall be paid at the Office of the Seller in Danville, Kentucky, monthly within ten days after the bill is presented. If the Consumer shall fail to pay any such bill within such ten day period, the Seller may discontinue service hereunder by giving ten days notice in writing to the Consumer.

3. Continuity of Service

The Seller shall use reasonable diligence to provide a constant and uninterrupted supply of electric power and energy; but if such supply shall fail or be interrupted, or become defective through the act of God, or the public enemy, or by accident, strikes, labor troubles, or by action of the elements, or inability to secure rights-of-way, or other permits needed, or for any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Seller, the Seller shall not be liable therefor.

4. Membership

The Consumer shall become a member of the Seller, shall pay the membership fee and be bound by the provisions of the articles of incorporation and by-laws of the Seller and by such rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by the Seller.

5. Succession

This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors, legal representatives and assigns of the respective parties hereto.

6. Deposit

The Consumer shall deposit with the Seller the sum of _____ on account of the cost of facilities required to make service available to the Consumer on or before the commencement of construction of such facilities. Such deposit shall be returnable to the Consumer in the form of a credit on each bill for service in the amount of _____ percent of the bill, which credits shall continue until they total \$ _____. No refund shall be made to the Consumer of any portion of the deposit remaining
