FARM AND HOME SERVICE

Availability

Available to the Customers of the Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation located on its lines for general farm and home uses including lighting, incidental appliances, refrigeration, cooking, heating and power for motors up to and including ten horsepower; all subject to the rules and regulations of the contract covering this service.

Rate

First	25 kilowatt hours or less per month	\$ 2.25
Next	50 kilowatt hours per month	- 4.0¢ each (R)
Next	125 kilowatt hours per month	- 2.0¢ each
Next	600 kilowatt hours per month	1.5¢ each
Over	800 kilowatt hours per month	1.2¢ each (R)

Minimum Charges

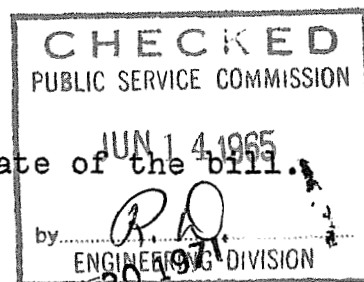
The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.25 where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

Type of Service

Single-phase at available voltage.

Terms of Payment

Payment is due within 10 days from the date of the bill.

SCHEDULE 2
COMMERCIAL, SMALL POWER, AND THREE-PHASE FARM SERVICE

Availability

Available to commercial, small power, and three phase farm customers of the Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation located on its lines for service including lighting, incidental appliances, cooking, heating, and motors, all subject to the established rules and regulations of the Corporation covering this service. Single-phase customers having their homes on the same premises may include farm and home service on the same meter.

Service under this schedule is limited to customers whose load requirements can be met by a transformer having a capacity not to exceed 25 KVA. Service under this schedule is not available to seasonal customers unless otherwise provided for.

Rate

First	25 kilowatt hours or less per month	\$2.25	
Next	50 kilowatt hours per month	4.0¢ each	(R)
Next	925 kilowatt hours per month	2.0¢ each	
Over	1000 kilowatt hours per month	1.5¢ each	(R)

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.25 net where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. Each customer who requires more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity shall pay, in addition to the above minimum, 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Where the minimum charge is increased in accordance with the terms of this section, additional energy therefor may be taken in accordance with the terms of the foregoing schedule.

Type of Service

Single-Phase, and three-phase where available, at available voltage.

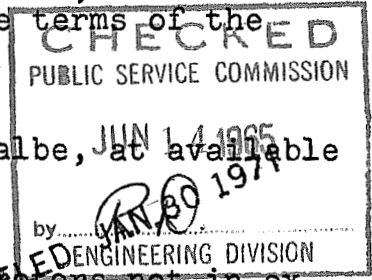
Conditions of Service

Single-phase power service is limited to motors not in excess of ten horsepower.

Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower must be three-phase.

Availability

Available to schools, churches and community halls for all uses subject to the established rules and regulations of the corporation covering this class of service.

Type of Service

Single-phase at available voltage.

Note: In case three-phase service is required
Schedule 2 shall apply.

Rate

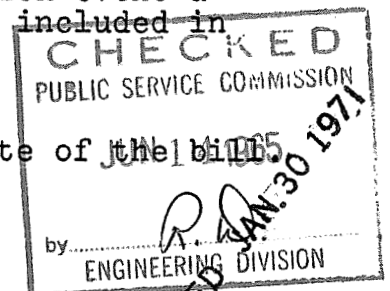

Between	18-25	kilowatt hours per month	2.25	
Next	50	kilowatt hours per month	4.0¢ each	(R)
Next	725	kilowatt hours per month	2.0¢ each	
Over	800	kilowatt hours per month	1.2¢ each	(R)

Minimum Charges

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$1.50 where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required, in which event a corresponding amount of additional energy shall be included in accordance with the foregoing rate.

Terms of Payment

Payment is due within 10 days from the date of the bill.

<p><u>AVAILABILITY</u> Available to all public or non-profit private schools whose total energy requirement, including but not limited to heating, air conditioning, lighting and water heating is supplied by electricity furnished by the cooperative.</p>	
<p><u>CHARACTER OF SERVICE</u> The electric service furnished under this rate schedule will be 60 cycle, alternating current, single phase or three phase service, present facilities permitting, and at the following nominal voltages: Single phase, 120, 120/240, 480, 240/480 volts; Three phase, 120/240, 120/208Y, 240/480, 277/480Y volts.</p>	
<p><u>RATE</u> 1¢ per KWHR</p>	
<p><u>MINIMUM CHARGE</u> The minimum annual charge will be not less than \$9.00 per KVA of required transformer capacity as determined by the cooperative.</p>	
<p><u>TERM OF CONTRACT</u> Service under this rate schedule will be furnished under an "Agreement for Purchase of Power" for a term of not less than five (5) years.</p>	
<p><u>SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS</u> Consumer shall furnish the cooperative information necessary to permit the Cooperative to determine and install the necessary transformer capacity to adequately service the load under maximum operating conditions.</p>

Availability:

Available to rural communities and villages for controlled multiple street lighting systems, furnishing lighting from dusk to dawn.

Base Rate:

<u>Lamp Size</u>	<u>Bare Lamp with Reflector Annual Charge Per Lamp</u>
100 watt	\$18.00

Conditions of Service:

1. Street-lighting equipment including lamps, fixtures, and the necessary street-lighting circuits, transformers and additional guys and fittings will be furnished by the Cooperative.

2. Lamp replacements will be made by the village. The Cooperative will furnish the tools for making replacements and will provide assistance whenever necessary.

AVAILABILITY

Available to consumers served by the Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, hereinafter called Seller, for all types of usage and subject to the established rules and regulations of the Seller and the conditions listed.

CONDITIONS

1. An "Agreement for Purchase of Power" shall be signed by the consumer for service under this schedule.

2. The consumer shall use an annual monthly average in excess of 999 Kilowatts (K.W.'s) when construction of consumer's facilities to use such service is completed.

3. Failure on part of consumer to use an annual monthly average in excess of 999 Kilowatts when construction of consumer's facilities to use such service is completed, his actual requirements shall be reviewed and the Sellers Applicable rate shall be applied to the consumer's usage.

TYPE OF SERVICE

The electric service furnished under this rate will be: Three-phase, 60 cycle, alternating current, at the Seller's standard voltages of 7.2/12.5Y and 14.4/25Y volts.

RATE

Maximum Demand Charge:

\$1.25 per month per kilowatt (K.W.) of billing demand.

Plus Energy Charges

2.0 Cents (¢) per KWH for the first 50 KWH used per month per KW of billing demand.

1.5 Cents (¢) per KWH for the next 100 KWH used per month per KW of billing demand.

0.72 Cents (¢) per KWH for all remaining KWH used per month.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for consumers with 50 KW or more measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 85%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 85% lagging.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the fuel cost adjustment per KWH in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question.

- (1) The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service.
- (2) A charge of \$0.75 per KVA of installed transformer capacity.
- (3) A charge of \$25.00.

SERVICE PROVISIONS

1. **Delivery Point.** If service is furnished at secondary voltage the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

If service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to Consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

2. Lighting. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate. If a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit, the registrations of the two-watt-hour meters shall be added to obtain total kilowatt-hours used and the registrations of the two demand meters shall be added to obtain the total kilowatt demand for billing purposes.

3. Primary Service. If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of seven per cent (7%) shall apply to the demand and energy charges, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of seven per cent (7%) shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, the Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt-hours and kilowatt demand.
