Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual charge, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge. The minimum annual charge shall be sufficient to assure adequate compensation for the facilities installed to serve the customer, and in no event shall be less than twelve times the monthly minimum as set forth in Rate Schedule 1-NF, 3-F and 6-C.

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Terms of Payment:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being ten percent (10%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within ten (10) days from the due date, the gross rates shall apply.

Special Terms and Conditions:

Service under this schedule is subject to the Special Terms and Conditions set forth herein.

Special Terms and Conditions Relating to the Application of Residential and Farm Rate

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Multiple-Family Dwellings:

Residential and Farm rates, Code 1-NF, 3-F and 6-C are based on service to single family units and are not applicable to multiple-family dwellings served through a single meter. Where premises include two or more residential or dwelling units, the residential rate may be applied only if separate circuits are provided without cost to the Distributor. A residential or dwelling unit shall be defined, for the purpose of applying this interpretation, as the space provided for the occupancy of a single family, including separate living quarters and kitchen. If it is not practical to provide for separate metering of each individual unit, the entire premises will be served under the appropriate commercial rate.

Commercial Use of Portions of Dwellings:

The residential rate is not applicable to the space in the dwelling which is regularly used for commercial purposes, such as offices, beauty shop, studio, tea room, or store, or for other gainful activities. In such cases, if a separate circuit is provided at no cost to the Distributor, for the portion of the dwelling so used, the residential rate will be applied to the balance of the power requirements and the commercial rate will be applied to the portion of the dwelling used for commercial purposes. If a separate circuit is not provided, the entire power requirements of the premises must be billed under the commercial rate. If the premises are used primarily as a private dwelling and space in the dwelling occasionally used for commercial purposes, such as occasional rentals of surplus rooms, dress making, laundering, etc., the residential rate should be applied to the entire power requirements.

Domestic Power Use:

A farm on which is located a single dwelling and its appurtenances, including barns, domestic servants quarters, and out-buildings, and which processes only its own products, shall be considered a domestic farm and shall be entitled to the residential rate for all of its power requirements, including motors up to and including rated capacity of five horsepower (5 H.P.). Motors of capacities larger than five horsepower (5 H.P.) shall not be installed except by written permission of the Cooperative. Service to dwellings other than the main buildings such as tenant houses, etc., must be separately metered and billed under the residential rate. This interpretation is not applicable to commercial dairies as defined below.

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Commercial Farm Use:

1. Farm service shall be metered and billed under the commercial lighting and power rate if other dwellings beside the main dwelling are not separately metered and are served through the

Commercial Farm Use: - Continued

same point of delivery, or if products of other farms are processed for sale. The main dwelling and domestic servants quarters may be metered and billed under the residential rate if a separate circuit is provided for all of the other farm uses in cases where products of other farms are processed for sale.

2. If a farm customer's barn, pump house or other outbuildings are located at such distances from his residence as to make it impractical to supply service thereto through his residential meter, the separate meter required to measure service to such remotely located buildings will be considered a separate service contract and billed as a separate customer.

3. All motors rated above one-half horsepower ($\frac{1}{2}$ H.P.) must be 240 Volt motors. All motor installations, fluorescent and other gaseous lighting installations must conform with the cooperative's power factor correction rule applicable thereto.

4. Three-phase service will not be made available under Rate Schedule 1-NF, 3-F and 6-C. Consumers requiring three-phase service shall be billed on the cooperative's applicable power rate subject to the rules and regulations covering such service.



Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual charge, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge. The minimum annual charge shall be sufficient to assure adequate compensation for the facilities installed to serve the customer, and in no event shall be less than twelve times the monthly minimum as set forth in Rate Schedule 2-C.

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Terms of Payment:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being ten percent (10%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within ten (10) days from the due date, the gross rates shall apply.

Special Terms and Conditions:

Service under this schedule is subject to the Special Terms and Conditions set forth herein.

Special Terms and Conditions Relating to the Application of Commercial Rate:

1. The Commercial Rate 2-C is available and shall be applied to all consumers using single-phase service 120/240 Volts, 60 cycle, alternating current, (except those to whom service is available under the Residential and Farm Rate, Code 1-NF, 3-F and 6-C) for lighting and general usage, and power for motors up to and including five horsepower (5 H.P.), or a total connected motor load not in excess of seven and one-half horsepower (7½ H.P.). Written permission must be obtained from the Cooperative for motors rated above five horsepower (5 H.P.).



Commercial Rate: - Continued

2. All motors rated above one-half horsepower ($\frac{1}{2}$ H.P.) must be 240 Volt motors. All motor installations, fluorescent, or other gaseous lighting installations must conform with the Cooperative's power factor correction rule applicable thereto. (As set forth in rate schedule for Commercial and Industrial Lighting and Power).

3. Three-phase service will not be made available under Commercial Rate 2-C. Consumers desiring to contract for three-phase service will be required to make application to the Cooperative for such service stating the location desired and shall be billed on the Cooperative's applicable power rate subject to the rules and regulations covering such service.

4. Consumers having a total connected power load in excess of 10 KW billing demand shall be billed on the Cooperative's appropriate rate schedule.

5. Temporary service shall be supplied under this rate except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service less the value of materials returned to stock. A deposit, in advance may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

Rates:

The rate for this service consists of two parts, as follows:

I. Investment Charge

The annual investment charge (for the cost of operations, maintenance, taxes, and depreciation, and for return on investment) shall be twelve percent (12%) of the investment in the street-lighting system, determined as set forth below. This charge will be recomputed on July 1 of each year and one-twelfth of the total annual charge so computed will be billed customer monthly.

Minimum Bill:

Consumers and municipalities receiving service under the above rate will be required to execute contracts for minimum terms of one year. The minimum monthly charge shall be the minimum charge specified in the contract for service.

Method of Determining Distributor's Investment:

The investment in property and equipment used as a basis for the investment charge contained in this schedule shall consist of the cost of such property and equipment, including the full amount shown in the plant account entitled "Street Lighting and Signal System". If any part of the street-lighting system has not been built at the expense of the Distributor, a deduction shall be made from the annual investment charge in the amount of six percent (6%) of the investment in such part.

Lamp Renewals:

Distributor shall keep a record of the number and type of lamp replacement and customer shall be billed monthly for the replacements during the month at actual cost to Distributor, including appropriate overheads.

Relocation of Lamps:

Distributor shall, at the request of customer, relocate or change existing equipment. Customer shall reimburse Distributor for such changes at actual cost, including appropriate overheads.

Metering:

All energy consumed under this schedule shall be metered excepting installations where, in the opinion of Distributor, metering would be impracticable.

Metering: - Continued

When the consumption is metered, the meters shall be installed in or connected to the lighting circuit and the billing shall include the energy delivered to and consumed in all circuits and equipment used exclusively for street lighting purposes. If more than one meter is used, the readings shall be consolidated for billing purposes.

When the energy is not metered and also when a meter reading is found to be in error, the consumption for billing purposes shall be computed from the rated capacity of the lamps plus five percent (5%) for losses, multiplied by the number of hours of use.

Payment:

The rates included herein are net, the gross rates being ten percent (10%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within ten (10) days from due date, the gross rates shall apply.

Due Date of Bill:

Payment of consumers monthly bill will be due within ten (10) days from due date of bill.

Delayed Payment Charge:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being five percent (5%) higher on the first \$25.00 and two percent (2%) on the remainder of the bill. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within ten (10) days from the due date of the bill, the gross rates shall apply.

Metering:

Necessary metering equipment will be furnished and maintained by the Cooperative, which shall have the option of metering service supplied hereunder at either primary or secondary voltage.

Special Rules and Conditions:

1. Meters having a rated capacity in excess of five horsepower (5 H.P.) must be three-phase unless written permission has been obtained from the Seller.
2. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
3. Service hereunder will be furnished at one location. If the consumer desires to purchase energy from the Cooperative at two or more locations, each such location shall be metered and billed separately from the other under the above rates.
4. When lighting is installed under the above rate, the lighting load shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the maximum power load. All equipment necessary to provide lighting shall be installed, owned and maintained by the Consumer.

Power Factor Adjustment:

The consumer shall at all times take and use power in such manner that its average power factor shall be as near one hundred percent (100%) as is consistent with good engineering practice, but in no case shall the power factor be lower than ninety percent (90%) lagging. The Distributor reserves the right to measure the power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than ninety percent (90%), the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by ninety percent (90%) and divided by the percent power factor. When the power factor is found to be lower than ninety percent (90%), the consumer will be required to correct its power factor to ninety percent (90%) at the consumers expense. The demand shall be defined as ninety percent (90%) of the highest average kilovolt-amperes measured during any fifteen consecutive-minute period of the month.

Fuel Cost Adjustment Charge:

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the fuel cost adjustment per KWH in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

Minimum Monthly Charges:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question.

1. The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service.
2. A charge of \$0.75 per KVA of installed transformer capacity, or \$0.75 per horsepower of connected load.

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Services:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Due Date of Bill:

Payment of consumers monthly bill will be due within ten (10) days from due date of bill.

Delayed Payment Charge:

The above rates are net, the gross rates being five percent (5%) higher on the first \$25.00 and two percent (2%) on the remainder of the bill. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within ten (10) days from the due date of the bill, the gross rates shall apply.

Metering:

Necessary metering equipment will be furnished and maintained by the Cooperative, which shall have the option of metering service supplied hereunder at either primary or secondary voltage.

Special Rules and Conditions:

1. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of five horsepower (5 H.P.) must be three-phase unless written permission has been obtained from the Seller.

2. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Services:



rate may be applied only if separate circuits are provided without cost to the Distributor. A residential or dwelling unit shall be defined, for the purpose of applying this interpretation, as the space provided for the occupancy of a single family, including separate living quarters and kitchen. If it is not practical to provide for a separate metering of each individual unit, the entire premises will be served under the appropriate commercial rate.

Commercial Use of Portions of Dwellings:

The residential rate is not applicable to the space in the dwelling which is regularly used for commercial purposes, such as offices, beauty shop, studio, tea room, or store, or for other gainful activities. In such cases, if a separate circuit is provided at no cost to the Distributor, for the portion of the dwelling so used, the residential rate will be applied to the balance of the power requirements and the commercial rate will be applied to the portion of the dwelling used for commercial purposes. If a separate circuit is not provided, the entire power requirements of the premises must be billed under the commercial rate. If the premises are used primarily as a private dwelling and space in the dwelling occasionally used for commercial purposes, such as occasional rentals of surplus rooms, dress making, laundering, etc., the residential rate should be applied to the entire power requirements.

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Domestic Power Use:

A farm on which is located a single dwelling and its appurtenances, including barns, domestic servants quarters, and out-buildings, and which processes only its own products, shall be considered a domestic farm and shall be entitled to the residential rate for all of its power requirements, including motors up to and including rated capacity of five horsepower (5 H.P.). houses, etc., must be separately metered and billed under the residential rate. This interpretation is not applicable to commercial dairies as defined below.

Commercial Farm Use:

1. Farm service shall be metered and billed under the commercial lighting and power rate if other dwellings beside the main dwelling are not separately metered and are served through the same point of delivery, or if products of other farms are processed for sale. The main dwelling and domestic servants quarters may be metered and billed under the residential rate if a separate circuit is provided for all of the other farm uses in cases where products of other farms are processed for sale.

2. If a farm customer's barn, pump house or other outbuildings are located at such distances from his residence as to make it impractical to supply service thereto through his residential meter, the separate meter required to measure service to such remotely located buildings will be considered a separate service contract and billed as a separate customer.

3. All motors rated above one-half horsepower ($\frac{1}{2}$ H.P.) must be 240 Volt motors. All motor installations, fluorescent and other gaseous lighting installations must conform with the Cooperative's power factor correction rule applicable thereto as set forth in rate schedule for Commercial and Industrial Lighting and Power1.

4. Three-phase service will not be made available under the Residential and Farm Rate, Schedule 1-EH and 3-EH.

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
