8. Estimated cost differential:

Where the facilities are located on front or street side of lot, a unit charge of \$1.35 per front foot will be made. This applies to where houses are to occupy both sides of the street. Where houses to be served occupy only one side of the street, the charge will be doubled. Lots running on two or more streets shall have frontage included along each street in which underground facilities are to be installed. Where rock is encountered and cannot be removed by conventional trenching machines, an additional charge of \$20.00 per cubic yard of rock removed will be made.
