## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. <u>Delivery Point</u>....If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the Contract for Service. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned by and maintained by the consumer.

If service is furnished at Seller's primary voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the Contract for Service. All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned by and maintained by the consumer.

2. <u>Lighting</u>....Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rates.

3. <u>Primary Service</u>....If service is furnished at 7200/12,470 volts or above, a discount of 5% shall be applied to the Demand and Energy Charge.

The Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage.

### TERMS OF PAYMENT

All of the above rates are net. A 5% penalty will be assessed T if a customer fails to pay for services by the due date shown on the customer's bill.
