<p><b>Large Power Service</b></p> <p><u>Applicable:</u></p> <p>Entire territory served.</p> <p><u>Availability of Service:</u></p> <p>Available to large power consumers.</p> <p><u>Type of Service:</u></p> <p>Three-Phase, 60 cycles. <i>110/220 or 220/440</i></p> <p><u>Rates:</u></p> <p>\$1.25 per month per kw of billing demand: Plus energy charge of -- 2.5¢ per kwh for the first 50 kwh used per month per kw of billing demand 2.0¢ per kwh for the next 100 kwh used per month per kw of billing demand 1.5¢ per kwh for all remaining kwh used per month</p> <p><u>Determination of Billing Demand:</u></p> <p>The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt load used by the consumer for any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.</p> <p><u>Power Factor</u></p> <p>The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at any time of his maximum demand is less than 80%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 80% and divided by the percent power factor.</p>

<p><u>Minimum Charge:</u></p> <p>The minimum monthly charge shall be the <u>highest</u> one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service.</li> <li>(2) A charge of \$0.75 per kva of installed transformer capacity.</li> <li>(3) A charge of \$25.00.</li> </ol> <p><u>Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service</u></p> <p>Consumers requiring service during not to exceed nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.</p> <p><u>Delayed Payment Charge:</u></p> <p>In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the date of the bill, five percent (5%) will be added to the bill.</p> <p><u>Special Rules:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.</li> <li>(b) Both Power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate. If a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit the registrations of the two watt-hour meters shall be added to obtain total kilowatt-hours used and the registrations of the two demand meters shall be added to obtain the total kilowatt demand for billing purposes.</li> <li>(c) All wiring, pole lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point, shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.</li> </ol>



<p>(d) If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of ten percent (10%) shall apply to the demand and energy charges and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of 10% shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, the Cooperative shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt-hours and kilowatt demand.</p>
