Schedule B

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND: The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT: The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for average power factors lower than 90% and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

MINIMUM CHARGE: The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$4.93 (1) for single-phase service. For three-phase service, the minimum monthly charge shall be determined by applying \$.75 for each KVA of transformer capacity installed. Payment of the minimum shall entitle a consumer in all cases the use of the number of KWH corresponding to the charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

TERMS OF PAYMENT: The above rates are net.
