DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND: The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT: The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for average power factors lower than 90% and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

MINIMUM CHARGE: The minimum monthly charge shall be the HIGHEST one of the following:

- The Consumer Charge No KWH Usage as stated in Rates Per Month, (a)
- The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for (b) service, or,
- A charge of \$0.80 per KVA of required transformer capacity. Seller may, if it so desires, install transformers of capacity larger than required, but in such case, the Consumer's minimum bill shall be based on the standard transformer size which would have been adequate for Consumer's load.

## CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

An agreement for purchase of power shall be executed by the COMMISSION Consumer for service under this schedule as deemed necessary by the Seller.

Delivery Point - If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

If service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service.

All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

- 3. Lighting Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate.
- 4. Primary Service The Seller shall meter at secondary distribution voltage unless it would be agreeable to both parties to primary meter.
