# <u>Section DSM - 8</u> Heat Pump Retrofit Program

### Purpose

The Heat Pump Retrofit Program provides incentives for residential members/owners to replace their existing resistance heat source with a heat pump.

## Availability

This program is available to residential members/owners served by South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation.

### Eligibility

This program is targeted to retail members/owners who currently heat their home with a resistance heat source; this program is targeted to site built homes, manufactured homes, and multi-family dwellings. Eligibility requirements are:

**(T)** 

- Incentive only applies when homeowner's primary source of heat is an electric resistance heat furnace, ceiling cable heat, or baseboard heat.
- Existing heat source must be at least 2 years old.
- New manufactured homes are eligible for the incentive.
- Air-Conditioning, Heating, and Refrigeration Institute ("AHRI") ratings may range as follows: Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio ("SEER") minimum 13; Heating Seasonal Performance Factor ("HSPF") minimum 7.5.
